AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING STOP SIGNS AT ALL RAILROAD CROSSINGS IN THE TOWN OF PLYMOUTH

The Town Board of the Town of Plymouth, do ordain as follows:

- SECTION 1. Pursuant to Wisconsin Statutes 349.06 (8), which authorizes Town government to place Stop signs at intersections which it has jurisdiction over.
- SECTION 2. Official Stop Signs are to be placed at all intersections of Town Roads and Wisconsin & Southern Railroad Crossings.
 - 2 Signs on South Footville Road
 - 2 Signs on Schaffner Road
 - 1 Sign on Johnson Road
- SECTION 3. Penalty for violating Town of Plymouth Ordinance 2001-01 are
 The same as the penalties under Wis Stats 346.49

 1st Offense forfeit not less than \$20. nor more than \$40.

 2nd Offense forfeit not less than \$50. nor more than \$100. if within one year.

 If the Offense occurs in a construction zone, penalties double.
