

TOWN OF PLYMOUTH
ORDINANCE NO. 2017-01

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING TOWN OF PLYMOUTH ORDINANCE NO. 1995,
WHICH DESIGNATED A PORTION OF PLYMOUTH CHURCH ROAD AS A HEAVY
TRAFFIC ROUTE

RECITALS

- A. In July of 1995, the Town of Plymouth (the "Town") adopted Ordinance No. 1995, which pursuant to section 349.17, Wis. Stats., designated Plymouth Church Road as a heavy traffic route.
- B. It is the desire of the Town Board to no longer designate Plymouth Church Road as a heavy traffic route and, as a result, it desires to repeal Ordinance No. 1995.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Town Board of the Town of Plymouth, County of Rock, State of Wisconsin, ordains as follows:

SECTION 1: AUTHORITY

This Ordinance is adopted by the Town Board of the Town of Plymouth pursuant to section 349.17, Wis. Stats.

SECTION 2: TITLE AND EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall be hereafter known, cited, and referred to as the *Ordinance Repealing the Heavy Traffic Route Designation of Plymouth Church Road* and shall be effective immediately upon posting of due notice of the adoption of the Ordinance.

SECTION 3: INTENT AND PURPOSE

It being determined that the designation of Plymouth Church Road as a heavy traffic route as set forth in section 349.17, Wis. Stats. is no longer necessary and that Plymouth Church Road is suitable for traffic that is within standard Class B weight limitations, the Town, in order to advance the public health, safety, and general welfare of its residents, wishes to repeal Ordinance No. 1995.


SECTION 4: REPEAL OF ORDINANCE NO. 1995

Ordinance No. 1995 shall be and hereby is fully and completely revoked and Plymouth Church Road shall no longer be designated as a heavy traffic route.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance is effective upon posting as required by law. The Town Clerk of the Town of Plymouth shall send a copy of this Ordinance to the Rock County Sheriff's Department.




