**PROPERTY TAX PAYMENT BY ECHECK**

Save a stamp or time standing in line at the Rock County Treasurer's Office by paying taxes by echeck. For a cost of only \$1 you can pay all your property taxes by echeck using GovTEch. The GovTEch site can be accessed through a link on the Rock County Treasurer's website or the Town of Plymouth website under taxes.

**2016 TOWN BUDGET:** At the November 17, 2015 Special Town Board meeting which followed the public budget hearing, the Town Board adopted the 2016 Town budget in the amount of \$426,649.00.

**ELECTIONS**

There will be 4 Elections in 2016. All voting is held at the Plymouth Town Hall from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. on each Election Day. Voters must be residents of the Town of Plymouth for at least 28 days before an election in order to vote here. If you need to register to vote or need an absentee ballot, contact Clerk Sue Douglas. On **Tuesday, April 19, 2016 at 7 pm**, the Town of Plymouth will have its Annual Town Meeting. This meeting provides an opportunity for Town of Plymouth residents to express their views, ask questions, and make decisions per State Statutes. ***This is YOUR meeting! ALL RESIDENTS SHOULD ATTEND.***

## CURBSIDE TRASH AND RECYCLING COLLECTION



Advanced Disposal (formerly Rock Disposal) is the service provider for trash and recycling collection. The cost for this service is listed as a special charge on property tax statements for parcels with residences. **TRASH** is collected **weekly** and **RECYCLABLES** collected **every other week on Wednesdays**. Everything should be placed in the provided carts.

**VEHICLE REGISTRATION**: When you register your vehicles with the Dept. of Motor Vehicles, make sure you indicate they are kept in the Town of Plymouth, not the city of your mailing address. It affects town revenues and taxes.

## DID YOU KNOW????????

- If you have a **DOG** you **MUST** get a dog license **EVERY YEAR**. Contact Treasurer at 608-290-2211.
- If you need to **REGISTER TO VOTE**, you **MUST** provide proof of residence. Contact Town Clerk at 608-876-6112.
- If you want to **VOTE ABSENTEE** (early voting) you **MUST** be a registered voter, apply, and provide an accepted Photo ID. Contact Town Clerk at 608-876-6112.
- If you have questions about your **PROPERTY TAX STATEMENT**, contact Town Treasurer at 608-290-2211.
- If you are installing or relocating plumbing, electrical, heating, and venting or air conditioning equipment, you **MUST** have a **BUILDING PERMIT**. Contact Building Inspector at 262-894-2546
- If you are building a new structure, adding on to existing structure, or making alterations to structures, you **MUST** have a **ZONING PERMIT** and **BUILDING PERMIT**. Contact Zoning Officer at 608-921-8114 and Building Inspector at 262-894-2546.
- If you are taking down or removing any building or structure from your property you **MUST** have a **RAZE PERMIT**. Contact Building Inspector at 262-894-2546.
- If you are replacing, altering, or installing a new **DRIVEWAY** you **MUST** have a permit. Contact Zoning Officer at 608-921-8114.



- If you have any questions or concerns about **TOWN ROADS**, contact Town Roads Officer at 608-879-2414.
- If you have any concerns about number of animals on a property, condition of a property, or any general **TOWN ORDINANCE**, contact Ordinance Officer at 608-449-5800.
- If you have questions about the **ZONING OF A PROPERTY** and what is permitted, need to rezone, need a conditional use permit, are dividing a parcel, etc. contact Planning & Zoning Committee Chairperson at 608-921-8114.
- If you are a property owner and have questions about your **ASSESSMENT**, contact Town Assessor, Associated Appraisal Consultants, Inc. at 800-721-4157.
- If you are **BURNING** items outside contact the Orfordville Fire Department at 879-2122 for clarification on what can be burned and to inform them when you plan to burn.
- If you do not keep 30 to 33 feet from the center of the road otherwise known as the **RIGHT-OF-WAY** clear of objects including but not limited to field crops and continuance use for vehicle parking, violation obstructions could be removed at the Town's discretion.
- If you are a property owner, State Law requires you to destroy all invasive and noxious **WEEDS** on your property.
- If your **FIRE NUMBER** is missing, damaged or simply faded order a replacement by contacting the Rock County Planning, Zoning and Development Office at 608-757-5587.
