**AN ORDINANCE
TO REGULATE HEAVY TRAFFIC
ON PLYMOUTH CHURCH ROAD
IN THE TOWN OF PLYMOUTH**

The Town Board of the Town of Plymouth do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF PLYMOUTH CHURCH ROAD AS A HEAVY TRAFFIC ROUTE. Pursuant to Wis. Stats 349.17 (1) and by doing so hereby declare Plymouth Church Road a "Heavy Traffic Route" and prohibit travel on the aforementioned road to "Heavy Traffic"

SECTION 2. In this Ordinance "Heavy Traffic" means all vehicles not operating completely on pneumatic tires and all vehicles or combination of vehicles other than motor buses, designed or used for transporting property of any nature and having a gross weight of more than 10000 pounds.

SECTION 3. This ordinance does not prohibit "Heavy Traffic" from using Plymouth Church road for the purpose of obtaining orders for supplies or moving or delivering supplies or commodities to or from any place of business or residence which has an entrance on such road.


SECTION 4. PENALTY

(a) Standard Penalty. Unless another penalty is expressly provided by any other ordinance of the Town of Plymouth for a violation of that ordinance, any person violating any provision of any ordinance, or any rule or regulation adopted or issued in pursuance thereof, or any provision of any code adopted therein by reference shall, upon conviction, be subject to a forfeiture of not less than \$5 or more than \$500 and the costs of prosecution for each violation. In default of payment of such forfeiture and costs where no showing of indigency is made, such person shall be imprisoned in the County jail until such forfeiture and costs of prosecution are paid, but not to exceed 90 days.
