2017 TOWN BUDGET: At the November 15, 2016 Town Board meeting which followed the public budget hearing, the Town Board adopted the 2017 Town budget in the amount of \$454,424.00.

TOWN CAUCUS: The caucus method is used by Town of Plymouth for nominating candidates to be elected for local offices at the Spring Election on April 4, 2017. Nominations are taken at the caucus for the Town Board: chairperson and 2 supervisors. Candidates for the clerk and treasurer positions are also nominated at the caucus. The caucus is held before the Town Board meeting in January. It is open to the public, but only qualified electors of the Town of Plymouth may vote.

TOWN OFFICE HOURS: Town of Plymouth Office, located in the Plymouth Town Hall, is open Saturdays from 10 a.m. - 12 p.m. and before the regular Town Board meeting on the second Tuesday of each month from 6:30 – 7 p.m. For other times, contact Clerk Sue Douglas at 876-6112.

2017 ANNUAL TOWN OF PLYMOUTH MEETING:

On **Tuesday, April 18, 2017 at 7 pm**, the Town of Plymouth will have its Annual Town Meeting. This meeting provides an opportunity for Town of Plymouth residents to express their views, ask questions, and make decisions per State Statutes. **This is YOUR meeting! ALL RESIDENTS SHOULD ATTEND.**

MAPLE GROVE CEMETERY: In April 2016, the Maple Grove Cemetery Association conveyed the cemetery property and management to the Town of Plymouth.

CURBSIDE TRASH AND RECYCLING COLLECTION:

Advanced Disposal is the service provider and the cost for this service is listed as a special charge on tax statements for parcels with residences. **TRASH** is collected **weekly** and **RECYCLABLES** collected **every other week on Wednesdays**. Everything should be placed in the provided carts. Call them for bulk pickup.

TOP PRIORITY INFORMATION

- ① **ADDRESS (FIRE) NUMBER:** Missing, damaged or simply faded numbers **MUST** be replaced. Contact the Rock County Planning, Zoning and Development Office at 608-757-5587.
- ① **ASSESSMENT:** Any questions about your assessment, contact Town Assessor, Associated Appraisal Consultants, Inc. at 800-721-4157.
- ① **BUILDING PERMIT:** A permit is required before installing or relocating plumbing, electrical, heating, and venting or air conditioning equipment. Contact Building Inspector at 1-800-422-5220.
- ① **BUILDING PERMIT and ZONING PERMIT:** Permits are required before building a new structure, adding on to existing structure, or making alterations to structures. Contact Zoning Officer at 608-921-8114 and Building Inspector at 1-800-422-5220.
- ① **BURNING:** Contact the Orfordville Fire Department at 879-2122 for clarification on what can be burned and to inform them when you plan to burn.
- ① **DOGS: ALL dogs MUST** have a new dog license **EVERY YEAR**. Contact Treasurer at 608-290-2211.
- ① **DRIVEWAY:** A permit is required before replacing, altering, or installing a new driveway. Contact Zoning Officer at 608-921-8114.
- ① **LOTTERY CREDIT:** Check your property tax statement to make sure you are receiving a lottery credit for the property where you live. Any questions contact Town Treasurer at 608-290-2211.
- ① **PROPERTY TAXES:** Any questions contact Town Treasurer at 608-290-2211.
- ① **RAZE PERMIT:** A permit is required before you take down or remove any building or

structure from your property. Contact Building Inspector at 1-800-422-5220.

- ① **TOWN ROADS:** Any questions or concerns about roads, contact Town Roads Officer at 608-921-0334.
- ① **TOWN ORDINANCES:** If you have any concerns about general ordinances such as condition of a property, dog kennels, and snowmobile routes, contact Ordinance Officer at 608-449-5800.
- ① **VEHICLE REGISTRATION:** When registering your vehicles with the WI Dept. of Motor Vehicles, make sure you indicate vehicle is kept in the Town of Plymouth, not the city of your mailing address. It affects town revenues and share of taxes.
- ① **VOTING:** Town Hall is the official poll location for voting. If a new resident, you **MUST** provide proof of residence to register to vote. All voters must provide a photo ID to obtain a ballot. For all voting questions, contact Town Clerk at 608-876-6112 or visit <https://myvote.wi.gov>
- ① **WEEDS:** WI State Law requires property owners to destroy all invasive and noxious weeds on their property.
- ① **ZONING OF A PROPERTY:** Questions on property's zoning and what is permitted; need to rezone; need a conditional use permit; or dividing a parcel, contact Planning & Zoning Committee Chairperson at 608-921-8114.
